



Android Bluetooth Terminal Software Guide


1. Execute the software and turn on Bluetooth




2. Turn on Bluetooth and Android device will ask you to allow, please press “Yes”




3. Connect the RS-232 adapter




4. Connect Ok. The color of the button will be Green color




5. Send the data from Android device to the remote device with RS-232
Touch the block and the soft keyboard display.



6. Receive the data from the remote device to Android device in Hex format




7. Receive the data from the remote device to Android device in ASC II format



8. Save the log data into the file in the memory

The default folder which the log file saved automatically is `./mnt/sdcard/ucbtadapter/`.
The naming convention is the date and serial number.



9. Select (Touch) and Send/Edit/Delete the file
